Wear clothing suitable for the weather and the activities you are taking part in. Dress should be modest and appropriate.

#### Leave no trace!

Use the recycling bins provided to help keep the site clean and tidy.

#### Shhhhh!

Please be quiet in all camping areas between 11pm - 6:30am.

### Fed and watered

Ensure you get plenty of sleep, food and drink to ensure you are fit and well!

## We're here for you

Our welfare team is here to help you and you can share any concerns with them.

#### Please remember

Alcohol may only be consumed by those aged 18 or over and at appropriate times. Smoking, including e-cigarettes and vapes are only permitted in designated areas and not inside tents.

The possession, personal use or supply of recreational drugs is illegal and as such, a criminal offence.

#### The law

As well as these helpful tips and rules please remember the law applies to the site. The Jamboree operates a zerotolerance approach to illegal behaviour. Anyone found to be breaking the law will be removed from site at their own expense and police will be informed.
