

Caravan and Motorhome Policy

As a Jamboree, we wish to ensure that all of our volunteers are accommodated on-site. Whilst many campers enjoy a 'back to basics' approach to camping, some prefer the creature comforts of sleeping in something other than a tent during their holidays. The alternative accommodation options are as follows:

- Caravan
- Motorhome (any motor vehicle equipped like a caravan for living in, be it purpose built or adapted to include living accommodation)

Whilst we will endeavour to accommodate all preferred choices, due to space limitations, we may need to restrict the number of caravans and motorhomes. So, as part of the phase 2 booking process, if you wish to bring a caravan or motorhome, you will be required to provide the reason(s). Please give as much detail as possible - especially with regards to additional requirements - and include who you will be sharing with.

All caravans and motorhomes will be allocated pitches in a dedicated area within the Staff Campsite. It may not be possible for you to camp with friends who are bringing tents. Arrival after 27th July 2024 or departure before 3rd August 2024 may be restricted.

On-site expectations - safety is paramount

The safety of all staff is paramount; therefore, users of caravans and motorhomes have a responsibility to minimise potential dangers by adhering to the following basic rules:

- Do not exceed the on-site speed limit of 10mph a fast walking pace. Take care at all times, especially when reversing. Pedestrians always have right of way when crossing site roads
- Use only your allocated pitch
- Correctly secure your caravan or motorhome
 - Adding chocks to caravan and motorhome wheels will prevent movement
 - Leave motorhomes in 1st gear, or in park if auto, with the handbrake applied
- Position gas cylinders in a safe and secure manner if you are unsure, seek advice from the Staff Campsite Team
- Keep external cables and pipes neat and out of the way. Where possible, clearly cover and/or mark potential trip hazards

Additional information

Caravan and motorhome users are expected to abide by all of the guidelines in the *Staff Handbook*. In addition, they are required to adhere to the following:

- 1. Report to the Operations Hub upon arrival before driving onto the Staff Campsite
- 2. Park towing vehicles only in the Staff Car Park not next to or near to caravans
- 3. Once pitched, caravans and motorhomes are not to be moved without the express permission of the Staff Campsite Manager
- 4. Caravans, motorhomes, awnings, and tents must be contained within your pitch
- 5. The use of electricity in caravans, motorhomes, and tents is subject to the conditions set out in the Guidance on campsite electricity at the Essex International Jamboree policy
- 6. The Jamboree will not be held responsible for damage to your property by fire or theft, or injury to persons on-site
- 7. Audio and/or visual equipment should be played at a respectable volume that does not disturb others
- 8. Caravans and motorhomes must not be washed on-site

The Staff Campsite Manager and their team will be on hand to help ensure that canvas, caravan, and motorhome campers are happy and safe. To prevent issues arising and help resolve them where they do, please adopt an open, honest, and positive attitude.

All directions and decisions made by the Staff Campsite Manager in collaboration with the Senior Management Team are final.
