

Noa's Club Policy

Noa's Club is for children, aged 0 - 10.5 years, of staff members, to enable them to carry out their staff roles, and will be available throughout the period of the Jamboree. It is hoped this will be from Friday 28 July to Saturday 3 August 2024, inclusive of both dates. There is an expectation that children will not be with their parents whilst they are working.

It is the intention of the Noa's Club staff to ensure that all young people, that are part of the club, enjoy a full and varied programme of activities and feel they are part of the Jamboree.

We want the children's time with us to be fun, exciting and sometimes even challenging. The programme of activities provided will be age specific within the 4 age groups, which are: 0 - 2 years, 3 - 4 years, 5 - 7 years and 8 - 10.5 years. There will be separate teams organising and running a selection of activities for each of the 4 age groups.

Noa's Club staff will be a mix of appropriately qualified and experienced staff, used to working with children within this age group and will include a nominated qualified First Aider. Further details of staff qualifications can be provided on request.

If a child has any specific needs or requirements these should be discussed with the team. There is little we cannot deal or cope with as long as we know about it in advance.

There will be 2 sessions daily running from 8.30 am to 12.30pm and then again from 1.30 pm to 5.30 pm. Snacks and drinks will be provided for children in the mornings and afternoons and packed lunches will be provided for them to eat in Noa's club at lunchtime. Parents are welcome to join their children in Noa's Club for lunch or can take them out. The choice is theirs. Where younger children or babies require milk/formula or baby food, this will need to be provided for the child(ren) and sent with them to Noa's club.

Children do not have to attend every day or for every session. However there will be a flat fee for the complete week and all sessions will need to be booked in advance of the Jamboree, where possible. There will be some flexibility for parents who have time off at the Jamboree and want their children with them, but we ask that Noa's Club staff are notified as soon as possible if this is the case or if there are any other changes to bookings.

Numbers are limited for the crèche and places will be allocated on a first come first served basis, once confirmation of a staff role has been received.
