

Position Statement on Dependent Children of Staff

Dependent children of staff at the Jamboree are defined as those under 18 years.

Children who are not yet participant age (under 10 years) are eligible for a place in Noa's Club (our on-site creche with a dedicated staff team). Numbers are limited and there is an additional charge of £35 for the week or part thereof. Places must be applied for and confirmed via the registration system.

Those aged under 10 who do not have a place in Noa's Club remain the responsibility of their parents and must be appropriately supervised at all times.

Parents must make suitable arrangements to ensure that supervision of children does not conflict with their Jamboree role.

Children aged under 10 will be included in the staff catering package.

Children aged 10-17 are expected to be participants or if they choose and are 16+, a staff member.

Children who are participant age but do not belong to a unit attending the event can, with the parent's agreement, be adopted by a suitable unit for the duration of the event and eat and sleep with this unit. In exceptional circumstances the parents can opt for the child to sleep with them on the staff subcamp. This arrangement must be made clear to the relevant managers.

Children aged 10-17 are not included in the staff catering package.
