

## **EIJ in a Day 2024 Information for Leaders**

EIJ in a Day 2024 is a **Jamboree experience day** for young members of Girlguiding and Scouting with their leaders who are not able to commit to the whole week, or who are from younger sections.

EIJ in a Day will run between Mon 29th July - Thur 1st August 2024

You will be welcomed onsite from 9am and will be hosted by one of our subcamps. You will experience the Jamboree, participate in some of the activities across 3 zones and have the opportunity to earn a badge before heading home at 5pm.

You will get the opportunity to meet with groups onsite during lunchtime

Whilst we welcome all members of Girlguiding and Scouting, the Jamboree site is very large (80 football pitches / almost 1 mile end to end / 30 minutes walk end to end) and totally greenfield (no pavements). Please be mindful of the capabilities of your young people and leaders before booking. Especially the very youngest members.

EIJ in a Day MUST be pre-booked. Walk-ins on the day will not be permitted entry.

### **Cost:**

£30 per under 18 (including young leaders/guide helpers),

£10 per leader

Appropriate ratios for your section must be adhered to.

Bookings will open on 5th April 2024

All bookings are non-refundable and we encourage groups to only book for confirmed individuals. Group numbers can be increased until we reach our maximum numbers.

Bookings must be made by 30th June.

If you have a group onsite that you would like to join, please let us know and we will try to put you together but cannot guarantee this will happen.

Leaders are responsible for ensuring that all young people have completed the appropriate forms required by Girlguiding / Scouting and have a home contact in place. Young people remain the responsibility of the leader-in-charge throughout the event.

**It is expected that Groups will meet in the car park and enter the EIJ site together  
The Leader in charge will confirm numbers in the group with registration team  
The Leader in charge has responsibility for forms required by each association, and  
for having appropriate home contact arrangements in place.**

**Please note:** Using public transport to get to and from the site is difficult and we encourage you to use cars or coaches.

**Terms and Conditions:**

1. EIJ in a Day visitors will be accepted as long as they meet the following criteria:
  - o Members of Girlguiding or Scouting
  - o Under 18's must be part of a group with its own leaders (association ratios must be adhered to)
  
2. All bookings will be checked to ensure association ratios rules are being met:
  - Squirrels: 1 adult to 4 Squirrels, plus the leader in charge with a minimum of 3 adults
  - Rainbows: 1 adult for every 5 Rainbows with a minimum of 2 adults
  - Beavers: 1 adult to 6 Beavers, plus the leader in charge with a minimum of 2 adults
  - Brownies: 1 adult for every 8 Brownies with a minimum of 2 adults
  - Cubs: 1 adult to 8 Cubs, plus the leader in charge with a minimum of 2 adults
  - Guides: 1 adult for every 12 Guides with a minimum of 2 adults
  - Scouts: 1 adult to 12 Scouts with a minimum of 2 two adults
  - Rangers: 1 leader with a recommended second adult
  - Explorers: 1 leader with a recommended second adult
  
3. As per main EIJ, bookings are not secure until full payment is received. Deadline for payment is 30 days from the approval email. Young leaders pay the participant rate.
  
4. Group leaders will be emailed if leader numbers appear excessively high.
  
5. It is expected that Groups will meet in the car park and enter the EIJ site together.
  
6. The Leader in charge will confirm numbers in the group with the registration team.
  
7. The Leader in charge has responsibility for day activity forms required by each association, and for having appropriate home contact arrangements in place.
