



EIJ in a Day

Notes for the day:

The car park will be open from 8.30am

There will be toilets in the car park and around the site.

All attendees will be required to wear a wristband. These will be provided on arrival and will show the telephone number of the leader in charge (from the booking form). This is in case of a lost/missing person or other emergency.

Tea and coffee will be provided to leaders by their host subcamp. Leaders must bring a lidded cup or these can be purchased onsite

Please advise us of any disabilities/mobility issues of young people or leaders.

We suggest each person brings a small rucksack to carry their packed lunch and water bottle.

As the site is large, a wheeled trolley will be useful for large groups or groups with younger members.

Please come prepared for all weathers. The campsite has very little shelter available.

No gazebos are allowed

Groups will leave together. Individuals will not be able to leave early and latecomers will not be allowed entry

Please note: Groups will be directed to activities with your subcamp hosts. Due to safety requirements, you will not be allowed to access all parts of the site.

Please remember the site is very large and there will be a lot of walking involved in the day. As a guide it is approximately 15 minutes walk from the car park to the main stage in the centre of the site.

Venues onsite

Time	Activity
9.00am - 9.30am	arrive on site and register group collect packs and attach wristbands
10.00 - 10.30am	meet subcamp team in front of stage
10.30 - 11.00am	subcamp team to take groups to zones
12.30 - 2.00pm	lunch break - this can be taken with onsite groups or in the main arena
2.00 - 2.15pm	subcamp team to take groups to zones
4.00pm	meet back in the arena for thank you and goodbye (having completed shopping etc)
4.30pm	Move to the car park Sign your group out with our Registration Team

Don't forget:

Groups must meet in the car park and enter the EIJ site together.

The Leader in charge must confirm numbers in the group with the registration team on arrival.
