Notes for the day:

The car park will be open from 8.30am

You will need to print and display a vehicle permit which can be found here: <u>Copy of Vehicle ID form - Google Docs (eii.org.uk)</u>

There will be toilets in the car park and around the site.

All visitors will be required to wear a wristband. These will be provided on arrival and will show the telephone number of the leader in charge (from the booking form). This is in case of a lost/missing person or other emergency.

We suggest each person brings a small rucksack to carry their belongings and water bottle. Please come prepared for all weathers. The campsite has very little shelter available. Due to safety requirements, you will not be allowed to access all parts of the site.

Please remember the site is very large and there will be a lot of walking involved in the day. As a guide it is approximately 15 minutes walk from the car park to the main stage in the centre of the site.
